Next week: We will be learning all about dinosaurs! We will be extending our vocabularies as we learn the names of different dinosaurs and the difference between carnivores and herbivores.

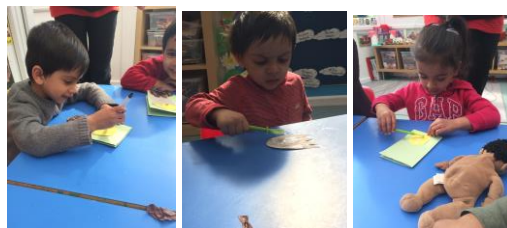
Bees, Caterpillars and Butterflies
