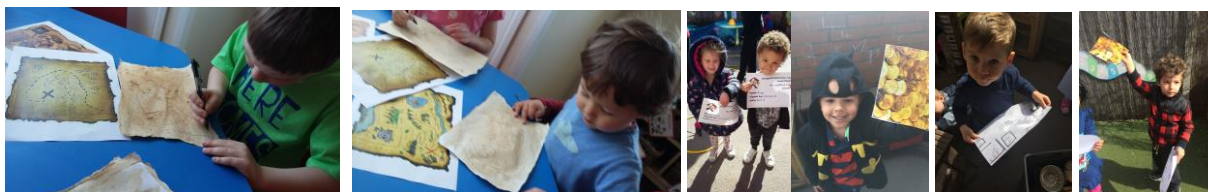


## Abbeywood Tots (Filton) Newsletter – May 2017
