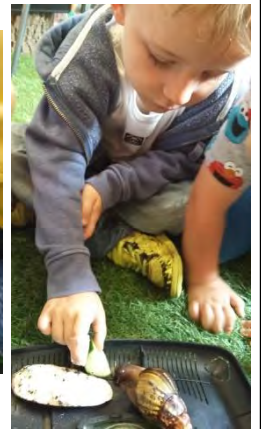


## Abbeywood Tots Stockwood News Letter
